Rules of free negotiable transmission capacities monthly auction for 2005 on SEPS-ČEPS cross-border transmission profile organised jointly by SEPS, a.s. and ČEPS, a.s.

The bottlenecks arise on the cross-border transmission profiles¹⁾ by demand outstripping the real transmission capacities. The process of allocating the cross-border transmission capacities of these bottlenecks is carried out through auctions. The used auction mechanism is based on the process of auction management implemented in the previous years by the German operators of the transmission systems and on SEPS – ČEPS profile in 2003 and 2004.

The auction is an objective, non-discriminatory and market-based process of the crossborder transmission capacities allocation eliminating the speculative behaviour and in compliance with the requirements of Regulation of European Parliament and the Council No. 1228/2003/EC, resulting in the transmission capacity reservation on the specified cross-border profiles in a given direction. It establishes the principles of the transmission system bottlenecks management required by the safe and reliable transmission system. The auction processes shall be carried out in accordance with the deadlines specified in <u>Attachment 3</u> to these rules.

All operations and steps implemented pursuant to these rules must have a written form or can be performed by fax.

The free negotiable transmission capacities for the calendar months of 2005 shall be allocated to participants through auctions. The capacities shall be offered as assured, except the provisions concerning the prevention of damages and provisions dealing with the issue of vis major, emergency situations and prevention of emergency situations by course of the generally binding legislation of the Slovak Republic and the Czech Republic.

1. Process of allocating the capacity

The auction of free negotiable transmission capacities available for 2005 and the respective calendar months of that year on SEPS-ČEPS cross-border transmission profile is organised by the Auction Office; for 2005 SEPS, a.s. Auction Office is concerned. The offer of free negotiable transmission capacities is done in dependence on direction of transmission. The auction 1 describes direction from ČEPS to SEPS and the auction 2 describes direction from SEPS to ČEPS.

These rules of free negotiable transmission capacity allocation shall define, that each participant in the auction must deliver a written application for the auction of the transmission capacity reservation until the crucial day at the latest. The application must include the data defined in article 3 of these rules.

¹⁾ A cross-border profile is a set of lines between two neighbouring transmission systems. In this case, the SEPS and ČEPS profile is concerned.

By the delivery of application for the auction, the participant in the auction takes over the obligation to pay down the Auction Office the qualified payment for the bottleneck management notwithstanding the fact if the reserved capacity is used or not.

A valid agreement with ČEPS on accession to trade conditions of the cross-border electricity transmission and the respective contract of transition (import, export) must be concluded before the use of the reserved capacity on transmission on ČEPS side pursuant to effective version of the Transmission System Code.

A valid agreement with SEPS, a.s. on accession to the transmission system and on provision of the transmission services must be concluded before the use of the reserved capacity on transmission on SEPS side pursuant to effective version of the Commercial Code and the Transmission System Code of the Slovak Republic.

Potential amendment to the rules of monthly auctions shall be the first time effective for the first following monthly auction and must be published by the Auction Office at the latest on the day determined for the free negotiable transmission capacities publication on the Auction Office web-site.

The reserved capacities are used on the basis of the implementation diagrams submission and their receipt by SEPS-ČEPS pursuant to article 6 of these rules. The implementation diagrams shall be accepted respecting the principle 1:1, i.e., the accession to SEPS-ČEPS networks for the cross-border transmission pursuant to the rules of both operators must be secured to a market participant submitting the diagram and a market participant shall submit the identical implementation diagram to both operators.

The Auction Office registers the market participants with the secured accession to SEPS and ČEPS networks respecting the principle 1:1 on the basis of information provided by both transmission system operators: SEPS and ČEPS. The Auction Office shall issue the confirmation of registration of the registered market participant upon his request.

2. Free negotiable transmission capacities

SEPS and ČEPS offer the free negotiable transmission capacities for the respective calendar months of 2005 on a joint cross-border transmission profile. These capacities will be published on ČEPS and SEPS web-sites according to deadlines defined by these rules.

3. Applications for auctions of the transmission capacity reservation

Regarding the participation in the auction process the applications must be delivered personally or as a recommended letter to the Auction Office with the confirmation of receipt by the Filing Room – with determination of date and time of receipt – in the sealed envelopes separately for each direction with the following filled identification on the envelope:

An order, in which the applications are registered in the advice of delivery, is determining in the case of collective delivery of applications for the auction.

Only one valid application can be delivered for one profile and one direction (see <u>Attachment No. 1</u> to these rules on the web-site). In the case if free negotiable transmission capacity auction for the respective month is concerned, the Auction Office will accept also the applications delivered by fax. The Auction Office will not guarantee the preservation of data confidentiality in the case of applications delivered by fax; it will however make an effort to secure the maximum safety of such data. A valid application must contain the following clear and readable data:

- 1. the identification of participant in the auction,
- 2. the information on the transmission direction (the number of auction),
- 3. the amount of the required reserved capacity in MW (in the integral numbers), at maximum equal the offered capacity,
- 4. the amount of the price offer in EUR/MW (with the accuracy of 2 decimal positions at maximum). (Offered prices of the free negotiable transmission capacity allocation and payment for the bottleneck management concern only the payment for the transmission capacity reservation, do not influence the obligation of payment for the agreed transmission),
- 5. the signature and stamp of participant in the auction.

The applications shall be delivered in a written form as stated in the attachment with all described data and must be unconditional. The Auction Office is allowed to accept for evaluation only one valid form of application for each direction containing several (however maximally 20) offers. The applications are binding and cannot be amended after submission. The applications can be withdrawn provided that a withdrawal is submitted in a written form at the latest at midday (12.00) on the crucial day for the registration of application.

The applications delivered by fax will be accepted only if verified by phone. A phone verification of the fax application acceptance shall be performed by the auction participant on the phone numbers of the Auction Office.

The applications, or the respective offers, failing to meet the specified requirements will be eliminated and will not be considered and classified among the evaluated applications/offers. The Auction Office shall observe the crucial date and hour of the application submission according to article 7 of these rules.

4. Implementation of auction

The Auction Office shall collect all applications delivered till 12.00 on the crucial day. The Auction Office shall consider the applications in terms of completeness and accuracy, classify them according to the offered price and prepare the evaluation.

In the case, if the amount of the required capacities in valid applications/offers does not exceed the offered free negotiable transmission capacity, the payment for bottleneck management equals zero, i.e. each participant in the auction shall obtain the required transmission capacity in the extent of valid offers free of obligation to pay for the bottleneck management.

In the case, if the amount of the required capacities in valid applications/offers exceeds the offered free negotiable transmission capacity, the payment for bottleneck management for each 1MW of the allocated capacity shall be determined according to the lowest price from the accepted offers. Such auction price shall be charged to all auction participants obtaining the reservation of the profile transmission capacity for each 1MW of the allocated reserved transmission capacity.

In the case of more requirements with the same offered price, the sum of which together with already accepted requirements exceeds the offered capacity, these requirements with the marginal price shall not be accepted and the remaining, i.e. unallocated transmission capacity will be offered in the daily auctions. The following table serves as an example:

In this case, the payment for the bottleneck management for this annual auction in a given year amounted to 22 EUR/MW. The participant in auction "a'' shall receive the allocated transmission capacity amounting to 60 MW and must pay EUR 1,320. Unallocated 50 MW will be offered in the daily auctions.

Offers of participants "d" and "a" – 20 EUR/MW – a marginal offer – shall not be accepted.

5. Auction result notice

The Auction Office shall provide each successful participant in the auction until the crucial day with the following information:

- 1. the information on the auction number (direction),
- 2. the period of the transmission capacity reservation,
- 3. the amount of the reserved transmission capacity for each auction participant in MW,
- 4. the auction price in EUR/MW for the period defined in article 2,
- 5. the payment for the bottleneck management in EUR for the period defined in article 2.

6. Use of the reserved transmission capacity

Reserving the transmission capacity on the cross-border transmission profile, the auction participant obtained the obligation from both concerned transmission system operators, that his transmission up to the level of the reserved capacity is realisable maintaining the standard level of reliability of the transmission systems operation with the exception of vis major, emergency situations and prevention of the emergency situations pursuant to generally binding legislation of the Slovak Republic and the Czech Republic.

Repaying the price for the bottleneck management, the reservation of the transmission capacity on the respective transmission profile and in the respective direction is effective. Assignation of rights to the reserved capacity is only possible upon the fulfilment of the following requirements:

- the auction participant shall repay the part of price for the bottleneck management linked with the acquirement of rights to the reserved transmission capacity use in the respective month,
- the market participant assigning the rights to the reserved capacity in accordance with the principles of <u>DAMAS e-Portal²</u> shall assign the capacity at the latest 3 days prior the beginning of period, for which the rights are assigned.

The rights to the reserved capacity can be assigned for the respective hours of a trading day.

All rights and obligations arising from these auction rules, with the exception of obligation to pay the price for the bottleneck management, shall be assigned together with the rights to the reserved capacity. Regarding the fact, that the capacity assignments are performed by Damas e-Portal, the subject assigning the rights to the reserved capacity as well as the assignee must meet the conditions of accession to Damas e-Portal.

DAMAS e-Portal shall register the assignation of rights; the assignation of rights is thereby effective. The market participant assigning the capacity (assignor) and the

market participant obtaining the capacity (assignee) shall obtain the confirmation on the validity of assignment.

A valid agreement with ČEPS on accession to trade conditions of the cross-border electricity transmission and the respective contract of transition (import, export) must be concluded before the use of the reserved capacity on transmission on ČEPS side pursuant to effective version of the Transmission System Code.

A valid agreement with SEPS on accession to the transmission system and on provision of the transmission services must be concluded before the use of the reserved capacity on transmission on SEPS side pursuant to effective version of the Commercial Code and the Transmission System Code of the Slovak Republic.

The reserved capacity use respecting the principle 1:1 means, that the use is enabled only to a registered market participant meeting the requirements of both transmission systems operators (SEPS, ČEPS) concerning the reserved capacities use. The subjects meeting this requirement are registered by the Auction Office on the basis of the information exchange between SEPS and ČEPS. Confirmation of this registration shall be issued by the Auction Office. The capacity may further be used jointly by two market participants – each meeting the conditions of only one transmission system operator – in the case, if they are registered as the exclusive partners for SEPS-ČEPS profile. The Auction Office performs the registration of the exclusive partners on the basis of a joint application of the exclusive partners. The registration is performed only for the whole calendar month and the application must be delivered to the Auction Office at least 5 working days prior the 1st day of a calendar month, for which the registration is required.

The reserved capacities are used on the basis of the implementation diagrams disposal respecting the principle 1:1. A compatible binding implementation diagram of transmission for the next day must be delivered by the market participant:

to SEPS till 8:00 AM to ČEPS till 8:00 AM

Amendments to the implementation diagram are not possible after this hour. The rights to the transmission capacity reservation use are executed on the basis of principle "use it or lose it", i.e. the transmission capacity not confirmed by the binding time schedule in the specified deadline will be reoffered in the framework of daily auctions of free negotiable transmission capacities to all market participants.

7. Crucial Days

- Free transmission capacities publication see <u>Attachment No. 3</u> to these rules
- Dead-line for submission of applications for the auctions see <u>Attachment No. 3</u> to these rules
- Publication of information on the auction results see <u>Attachment No. 3</u> to these rules
- <u>Attachment No. 3</u> to these rules is available on the web-site.

8. Payment for the bottleneck management

The following requirements are valid for the payment of price in relation to the bottleneck management arising from the free negotiable capacity auction for the calendar months of 2005:

- The announced amount of payment for the bottleneck management is payable within 5 days following the announcement of the auction results.
- The payment is considered the condition of obtaining the rights to the reserved transmission capacity use in the respective month.
- In the case of failure to pay this amount in a due date, the reservation of the transmission capacity does not become effective and the auction participant loses the rights to the reserved capacity. This capacity is offered in the daily auctions of free negotiable capacity for the next days of the respective month of 2005.
- The day of payment is meant the day of putting the amount to the account of the Auction Office.
- All bank fees shall be borne by the auction participant.

The Auction Office is authorised to amend the payment in line with the increased costs (e.g. change or introduction of taxes, fees etc.)

9. Solution of disputes

The auction participant and the Auction Office shall make the maximum effort to solve the potential disputes arising from the process of yearly auction by a consent decree. The disputable matters shall be negotiated by the authorised representatives of the auction participant and the Auction Office. The claiming party is obliged to ask the other party in written to solve a dispute. The claiming party shall describe a dispute and in the case of claim valuable in terms of money determine the amount of claim or define the requirement and submit the evidence supporting the claim. The notice shall be delivered to the other party personally or as a recommended.

In the case of failure to solve a dispute in 30 days from the date of delivering the notice regarding the solution of a dispute according to these rules and legislation of the Slovak Republic, the Auction Office or the auction participant can bring the action before the competent court of the Slovak Republic.

In the case of failure to solve a dispute in 30 days from the date of delivering the notice regarding the solution of a dispute provided that the domicile of the auction participants is outside the territory of the Slovak Republic, the disputes are solved in the arbitration proceeding of the Arbitration Tribunal of the Slovak Chamber of Commerce and Industry according to these rules, legislation of the Slovak Republic and using the arbitration order of this Arbitration Tribunal.
